
### TRIALS AND ARBITRATIONS

- Won a defense jury verdict in a **\$66M** product liability trial.
- Won a defense jury verdict in a three-week asbestos wrongful death trial.
- Won a defense jury verdict in an obstetrical malpractice trial.
- Won a **\$14.3M** arbitration award in a cannabis industry franchise dispute.
- Won a defense jury verdict for a lawyer and law firm in a **legal malpractice trial**.
- Won a multimillion-dollar **plaintiff's verdict** in a breach of contract jury trial.
- Won a breach-of-contract arbitration for a **Fortune 50 company**.
- Won a defense jury verdict in a \$120M medical malpractice case.

# HIGHLIGHT: MICHELIN DEFENSE VERDICT

A WTO trial team won a unanimous defense jury verdict for Michelin North America following a high profile, \$66 million product liability trial in South Carolina.

WTO demonstrated to the jury that the accident resulted from under-inflation and improper maintenance of a motorcycle tire.



#### LITIGATION

- Succeeded in a **\$2B** dispute surrounding the Denver Broncos franchise.
- Succeeded in a **\$100M** federal antitrust class action involving natural gas pricing.
- Resolved a telecom MDL involving 18 underlying class actions.
- Defeated certification of a joint employment class action.
- Won summary judgment in two sevenfigure asbestos cases.
- Defeated a third class-certification effort against Volvo in long-running litigation.
- **Preserved exclusive rights** for independent distributors.
- Won a preliminary injunction related to COVID health policy.

#### **APPEALS**

- Won a published opinion protecting a \$900M oil and gas investment.
- Won **Sixth Circuit** victory for a product manufacturer in a commercial licensing dispute.
- Successfully defended a new redistricting map to the **Colorado Supreme Court**.
- Won an appeal for Ford in the **Tenth Circuit**.
- Won a legal malpractice appeal in a \$500M estate dispute in Kentucky.
- Won **Eighth Circuit** victory for an insurance company.

HIGHLIGHT: MAJOR OIL & GAS APPEAL

A WTO appellate team secured a 3-0 published decision from the Colorado Court of Appeals upholding two summary judgment rulings for Crestone Peak Resources.

The victory protects several of the client's oil and gas leases that are strategically important to a \$900 million investment in the DJ Basin.





WTO lawyers helped clients pursue justice, whether seeking asylum or righting the wrongs of violence and discrimination.

## **PRO BONO RESULTS**

- Won a major excessive force settlement for a police brutality survivor.
- Won a trial for a Romanian national who brought claims involving **Hague Convention violations**.
- Won an appellate decision for an online education provider.
- Achieved favorable settlement in a workplace discrimination case.



#### **PRO BONO HIGHLIGHT**

WTO lawyers represented a Black teenager who was assaulted by police in 2018. At the time, she was 17 years old and pregnant, and was accused of possessing drug paraphernalia while visiting a county courthouse.

WTO successfully negotiated a \$495,000 settlement, one of the highest excessive force settlements in Colorado not involving significant physical injury.




#### **PRO BONO HIGHLIGHT**
